BOWLERO YOUTH CLASSIC TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBLITY: The Bowlero Youth Classic is a certified tournament that is open to all youth bowlers, both boys and girls. All bowlers who were 17 years of age and under on 8/1/23 are eligible to participate. **Each bowler must bring proof of age (State-issued identification, birth certificate, or passport) on the day of check-in and must have their parent or legal guardian sign the application form.** All entries and payments will be processed through LeaguePals.com.

PLAY RULES: Unless otherwise provided, the playing rules (available at www.bowl.com) of the U.S. Bowling Congress will govern the Tournament.

A. Scores will be entered on official Tournament recap sheets after each game. Participants must sign each recap sheet after each game and submit the same to the official scorekeeper or tournament manager. Such signature shall constitute participant's certification as to the accuracy of the score. Participants are solely responsible for the maintenance and submission of their own recap sheet. B. All bowling balls are required to satisfy the specifications (available at www.bowl.com) of the U.S. Bowling Congress. C. Bowlero Corp. may terminate or suspend the play of any participant causing unreasonable delays, disorderly conduct, or otherwise violating the code of conduct of the facility. D. Tournament officials have sole and absolute discretion to accept or reject any entry of a participant in the Tournament. All decisions of Tournament officials are final, binding and non-appealable.

E. Participants must report at least 30 minutes prior to commencement of competition at the facility. Late arriving or 'no-show' participants will receive no accommodation for scoring, refunds or otherwise.

FORMAT: There will be four (4) squads available at each location; Saturday and Sunday 9am and 2pm each day. The maximum number of participants will depend on the facility.

- A. Bowlers will complete four (4) games of
- Singles competition

B. All bowlers will bowl scratch (no handicap) in each Division C. Bowlers will get ten (10) minutes of practice prior to the start of competition

D. At the conclusion of the tournament, final standings in each Division will be tabulated based on total scratch pinfall of all four (4) games across all 4 squads

i. In the case of a tie (within a division), all participants will receive said prize

Receiving a prize is contingent upon compliance with these rules. The potential winner's parent or legal guardian will be required to execute certain documents, which may include, without limitation, an affidavit of eligibility, liability release, and applicable tax forms, and no prize will be awarded until such documentation is complete.

DIVISIONS: There will be three (3) separate divisions based on age as of August 1, 2023: 9yrs & under, 10yrs-13yrs and 14yrs-17yrs.

LANE PATTERN: Lanes will be conditioned prior to each squad. 'Big Ben' will be the tournament lane pattern and will be used throughout the duration of each event at all locations.

ENTRY FEE/AWARDS: The entry fee for each participant is \$40 and such fees are allocated as follows: \$20 (tournament prize fund) and \$20 (lineage fee). Walk in entries will be accepted up to two (2) hours prior to the start of each squad if space is available.

A. For participants entering the tournament more than once, each additional entry is 40

B. Prizes for each division will be:

- i. 1st place \$4,000
- ii. 2nd place \$2,000
- iii. 3rd place \$1,250
- iv. 4th place \$750
- C. One (1) award will be given to every 3 participants

D. If a participant bowls in multiple squads, they can only win one (1) top award (1st-4th) but could win additional awards, thereafter.

The above prizes will be awarded in the form of scholarships deposited through the SMART program from Account #13060; monies will be disbursed approximately 14 days following winner verification.

REFUNDS: Entrants that notify the tournament director at least 24 hours prior to their scheduled squad are entitled to a full refund (minus credit card fees if applicable) if they cannot bowl. Cancellations less than 24 hours prior to the schedule squad and no-shows are not entitled to a refund. Please contact a tournament director at BYC@BowleroCorp.com.

DRESS CODE: Participants are expected to wear attire suitable for participation in the Bowlero Youth Classic. Examples of prohibited attire include, but are not limited to, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, headphones/earbuds (permitted for medical reasons only), sleeveless shirts or tops and workout attire (athletic shorts, sweats, yoga pants, leggings, etc.). Profanity or inappropriate wording is not allowed. Jeans (no holes) and hats are acceptable. Skirts, dress shorts, culottes or skorts are permitted provided the length is beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament director, whose decision will be final.

PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEO: Participants agree to allow Bowlero Corp. to use their name and likeness, including capturing photographs and/or video to promote the Bowlero 2024 Youth Classic Tournament and participants will not receive any compensation or consideration therefor.

RELEASE: By participating in this tournament, participants and their respective parents, legal guardians, and other family members agree to release and hold harmless Bowlero Corp., the tournament facility, and each of their parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, insurers, divisions, predecessors, successors, consultants, and suppliers, and each of its and their respective officers, directors, managers, employees, agents, members, shareholders, and representatives from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the tournament or receipt, redemption or use of any prize.

DISPUTES: Each participant agrees that any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the tournament shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in Virgina. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these rules and the operation and administration of the tournament, a participant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of Bowlero or the facility in connection with the tournament, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of Virginia, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules.
